

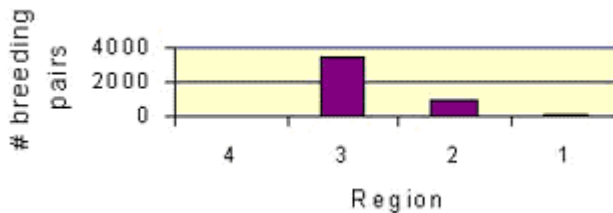


## Conservation Status of South Australia's Breeding Seabirds Cormorants

### Black-faced Cormorant *Phalacrocorax fuscescens*



#### Distribution:



**Range:** Endemic to Australia, occurs south-eastern coastlines and small part of Western Australian coast. In South Australia, found primarily in Gulfs waters

**Migratory behaviour:** Largely sedentary, with some dispersal by juveniles

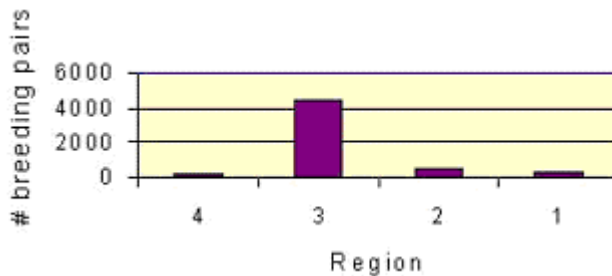
**Diet:** Small coastal fish are major prey.

### Pied Cormorant *Phalacrocorax varius*



#### Distribution:



**Range:** Widespread on coastal, subcoastal and inland waters throughout Australia. Recorded in all regions of South Australian coastline.

**Migratory behaviour:** Adults are largely sedentary, juveniles undertake some dispersal.

**Diet:** Feeds mainly on fish and a few crustaceans.
