

NOTE FOR USER OF *PHYTOPHTHORA* MAP ON THE EYRE PENINSULA

- “**Reported**” *Phytophthora* infestation is an infestation that has been reported through visual inspection.
- “**Suspected**” *Phytophthora* Infestation: all *Phytophthora* infestations on this map are displaying visual symptoms of *Phytophthora* dieback, but *Phytophthora* has not been confirmed in the soil test or soil testing has not been conducted.
- *Phytophthora* data are current as per May 2007.
- *Phytophthora* infestations are suspected in the following Department for Environment and Heritage reserves:
 - Tucknott Scub CP
 - Wanilla CP
- This distribution map of *Phytophthora* infestations is considered incomplete and *Phytophthora* infestations may be present elsewhere. Please report suspicious group(s) of dead or dying plants.
