<p>This list has been derived from data extracted from the Biological Survey, Opportune, Plant Population and Reserves databases which are components of the Biological Databases of South Australia managed by the Department for Environment and Heritage.</p> <p>The lists are intended to provide an accurate summary of indigenous and naturalised species recorded for a Reserve. However, since the information within the databases has come from a variety of sources and methodologies the species list may contain errors and should be used with caution. The Department's policy is to not record planted species. However, where planted species have been recorded, they are listed as "rejected".</p> <p>Most Reserves do not have comprehensive species lists backed up by specimen collection and accordingly conclusive checking of species determinations may be limited.</p>
