Don't let it onto your property

- Phytophthora dieback is a serious disease that kills many:

native plants,
citrus,
nuts,
ornamentals,
some vegetable crops,
grapevines,
young pines and lupins and more!

Protection is simple

- Insist that all earth moving equipment brought onto your property is cleaned before entering.

The question to ask all contractors

Do you have hygienic practice & clean equipment?

Don't let Phytophthora dieback be brought onto your property.



- Remove soil from shoes and vehicles before leaving an area. Don't bring it onto your property.
- Protect your garden. Don't dig up bush plants and soil as they may have the disease.



Phytophthora dieback effects Banksias and many other understorey species.



Yuccas are very susceptible to Phytophthora dieback and are a good indicator of its presence.
