

## Marine parks road show in Adelaide

After touring around regional South Australia since the beginning of the year, the marine parks road show will visit key locations in Adelaide during the next couple of weeks.

Communities from Port Noarlunga to St Kilda will be able to learn about marine parks and ask questions about managing South Australia's precious marine environment.

Andrew Burnell from the Department for Environment and Heritage (DEH) encourages everyone with an interest in the marine parks process to visit the information tent when it's in their area.

"We want to make contact with as many people as we possibly can to provide them with the latest information about marine parks," he said.

"People may have specific questions about marine parks and the information booth is the ideal location for a one-on-one discussion.

"We want to hear from people who live in or visit their local coastline.

"We're particularly keen to learn about any changes people have observed over the years in their area."

According to Mr Burnell, visiting the information tent is the best way for people to get up-to-date information, share their local knowledge and add their name to the mailing list to receive more information in future.

"We want to ensure the new marine parks are areas of marine conservation and sustainable use that local communities are proud of," he said.

"To do this we want as much community involvement in the planning phase as possible."

The marine parks information tent will appear at the following locations:

- September 20 (Sat) **Port Noarlunga** near the jetty (10am – 4pm)
- September 21 (Sun) **Port Adelaide** at the wharf (10am – 4pm)
- September 25 (Thu) **Rundle Mall** east of Gawler Place (10am – 5.45pm)
- September 27 (Sat) **West Beach** at the Adelaide Shores boat ramp (10am – 4pm)
- September 28 (Sun) **St Kilda** at the boat ramp (10am – 4pm)
