



TEMPORARY PROHIBITION NOTICE Section 18(2) - MARINE PARKS ACT 2007

UPPER GULF ST VINCENT MARINE PARK

Notice is hereby given pursuant to section 18(2) of the *Marine Parks Act 2007* that it is prohibited for any member of the public to come within 50 metres of a carcass of a marine mammal if that carcass is located anywhere within the boundaries of Upper Gulf St Vincent Marine Park.

This prohibition operates for a period of 90 days from the date this notice appears in the Government Gazette.

Failure to comply with this notice may result in liability for criminal prosecution with a maximum penalty of \$100,000 or two years' imprisonment.

For the purpose of this notice, "member of the public" means any person other than:

- a public authority as defined in the *Marine Parks Act 2007*, or a person authorised by a public authority;
- the Executive Director, Conservation and Land Management; the Director, National Parks and Wildlife under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*; or, the Manager, Marine Parks Unit, Department of Environment, Water and Natural Resources, or a person authorised by these officers; or
- authorised officers under the *Marine Parks Act 2007* or the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*.
