

BASIC KEEP & SELL PERMIT (Class 1) PROTECTED ANIMALS SOUTH AUSTRALIA 2017-18

A Basic Keep and Sell Permit is a permit issued pursuant to section 58 of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972* that entitles the holder (being a person who does not carry on the business of dealing in protected animals) to keep 2 or more of the animals of the species listed in Schedule 6 of the *National Parks and Wildlife (Wildlife) Regulations 2016* or to sell or give 1 or more of the animals of the species listed in Schedule 6 of the *National Parks and Wildlife (Wildlife) Regulations 2016*.

Information supplied on this form will enable your application to be processed as prescribed by the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*. Your application must be assessed and a permit granted before you can proceed with the proposed activity. Your application may take up to ten (10) business days to process.
