# INTERPRETING HERITAGE PLACES

*This year's competition encourages students to develop interpretive products for significant heritage places and offers three quite different entry categories and prize opportunities.*

*It retains the successful ICT component of previous years, as well as the 'Postcards Award' introduced in 2007, but this year the Department for Environment and Heritage is also offering an exciting new opportunity for students to contribute to the protection and promotion of heritage places through the implementation of their interpretive plan.*

Year 8-12 students (including special classes) are invited to submit entries in the following categories:

#### **On-site interpretation to enhance visitor experiences**

signs, brochures, plaques, artwork, trail guides, etc

(prize: working with a professional interpreter and designer, and up to \$5000 funding support, to realise the interpretation plan)

#### **Interpretation through television**

an 'on-camera' presentation similar to lifestyle TV programs such as *Postcards* or *Getaway*

(prize: the opportunity to work with Channel 9's *Postcards* team to produce a segment for the show)

#### **Electronic Interpretation**

PowerPoint, DVD or Website

(prize: \$100 cash)
