

National Parks Additions and Leases

Crown Lands provides property services to support the National Parks and Wildlife function within the Department for Environment and Heritage.

Functions performed by Crown Lands include issue, amendment and cancellation of leases and licences under the [National Parks & Wildlife Act 1972](#), maintaining a register of leases and licences and reviewing fees and rents. Assistance is also provided in the acquisition of land and processes for additions to the parks system.

The decision on lease or licence issue, or land to be added to parks, remains with National Parks & Wildlife staff. Service delivery is provided by Crown Lands.

- Licences may be issued for a variety of purposes (eg beekeeping, grazing, pump and pipeline, boat mooring). Leases are issued for shacks, grazing in regional reserves, concessions, etc.

Rentals are determined in accordance with advice from the Valuer General.

- Park additions can include addition of Crown land or acquisition of land in accordance with the Comprehensive and Representative Reserve System (CARRS) program.

A well-defined process that includes consultation with Primary Industries (Mines) and Cabinet Submissions has been developed.
