



TEMPORARY PROHIBITION NOTICE
Section 18(2)(c) - MARINE PARKS ACT 2007
ENCOUNTER MARINE PARK

Notice is hereby given pursuant to section 18(2)(c) of the *Marine Parks Act 2007*, that it is prohibited for any member of the public to:

- enter into, or upon, the Oceanlinx wave convertor; or
- enter the designated zone around the Oceanlinx wave convertor

located in Encounter Marine Park at:

NW corner	S 35 25.154 E 138 18.279
NE corner	S 35 25.174 E 138 18.417
SW corner	S 35 25.286 E 138 18.262
SE corner	S 35 25.319 E 138 18.389


This prohibition operates for a period of 90 days from the date this notice appears in the Government Gazette.

No member of the public may enter the designated zone at any time in this period. Failure to comply with this notice may result in liability for criminal prosecution with a maximum penalty of \$100,000 or two years' imprisonment.

For the purpose of this notice, "member of the public" means any person other than:

- a public authority as defined in the *Marine Parks Act 2007*, or a person authorised by a public authority;
- the Director, Transport Safety Regulation or the Manager, Marine Services, Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure or a person authorised by either officer; or
- the Executive Director, Conservation and Land Management, or the Manager, Marine Parks Unit, Department of Environment, Water and Natural Resources, or a person authorised by either officer, or authorised officers under the *Marine Parks Act 2007*.
