# Management Plan Amendments

The Western Kangaroo Island Marine Park Marine Park Management Plan was adopted in 2012. It provides the statutory basis for the management of Western Kangaroo Island Marine Park. It is a strategic document that defines the boundaries of the various zones and sets out strategies to address management challenges.

The Minister for Environment and Water may amend a marine park management plan at any time. As required under the *Marine Parks Act 2007*, a draft amendment must first be prepared and released for public consultation.

The Western Kangaroo Island Marine Park Management Plan Draft Amendment is now released for public consultation. Members of the public are invited to make a submission.

After all submissions have been received and considered, a final marine park management plan amendment will be prepared and forwarded to the Minister for Environment and Water for consideration, together with a detailed analysis of submissions received.

This draft amendment proposes the following alterations to the Western Kangaroo Island Marine Park Management Plan.

### Amendment 1 – Habitat Protection Zone (HPZ-1)

This amendment will extend HPZ-1. It is proposed in response to proposed alterations to SZ-3 (see Amendment 2).

#### Current plan content

##### Page 13 (6.1.1. Habitat Protection Zones)

(a) the area defined in map 04 and referred to as HPZ-1;

#### Replace with the following:

(a) the area defined in map 04(A) and referred to as HPZ-1 (see map 04(A) attached);

### Amendment 2 – Sanctuary Zone (SZ-3)

This amendment is proposed to alter the boundaries of SZ-3.

#### Current plan content

##### Page 14 (6.1.2. Sanctuary Zones)

(c) The area defined in map 03 and referred to as SZ-3;

#### Replace with the following:

(c) The area defined in map 03(A) and referred to as SZ-3 (see map 03(A) attached);

### Amendment 3 – Boundary Definition Maps

This amendment is proposed to confirm the maps that will define the altered zone boundaries.

#### Current plan content

##### Page 14 (6.2. Boundary Definition Maps)

The zones identified above are defined in Boundary Definition Western Kangaroo Island Marine Park Maps 00-05 (refer Appendix 1).

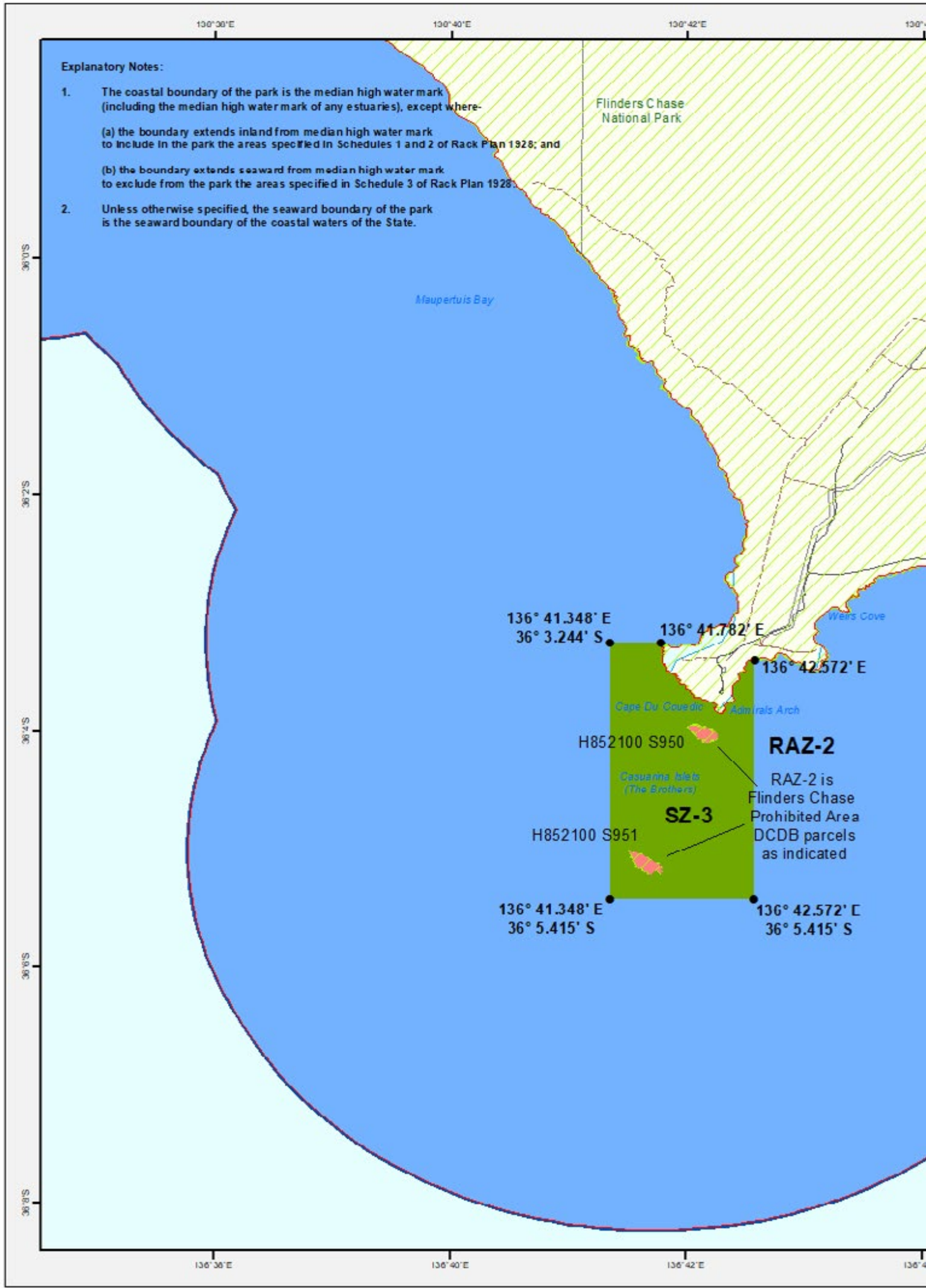

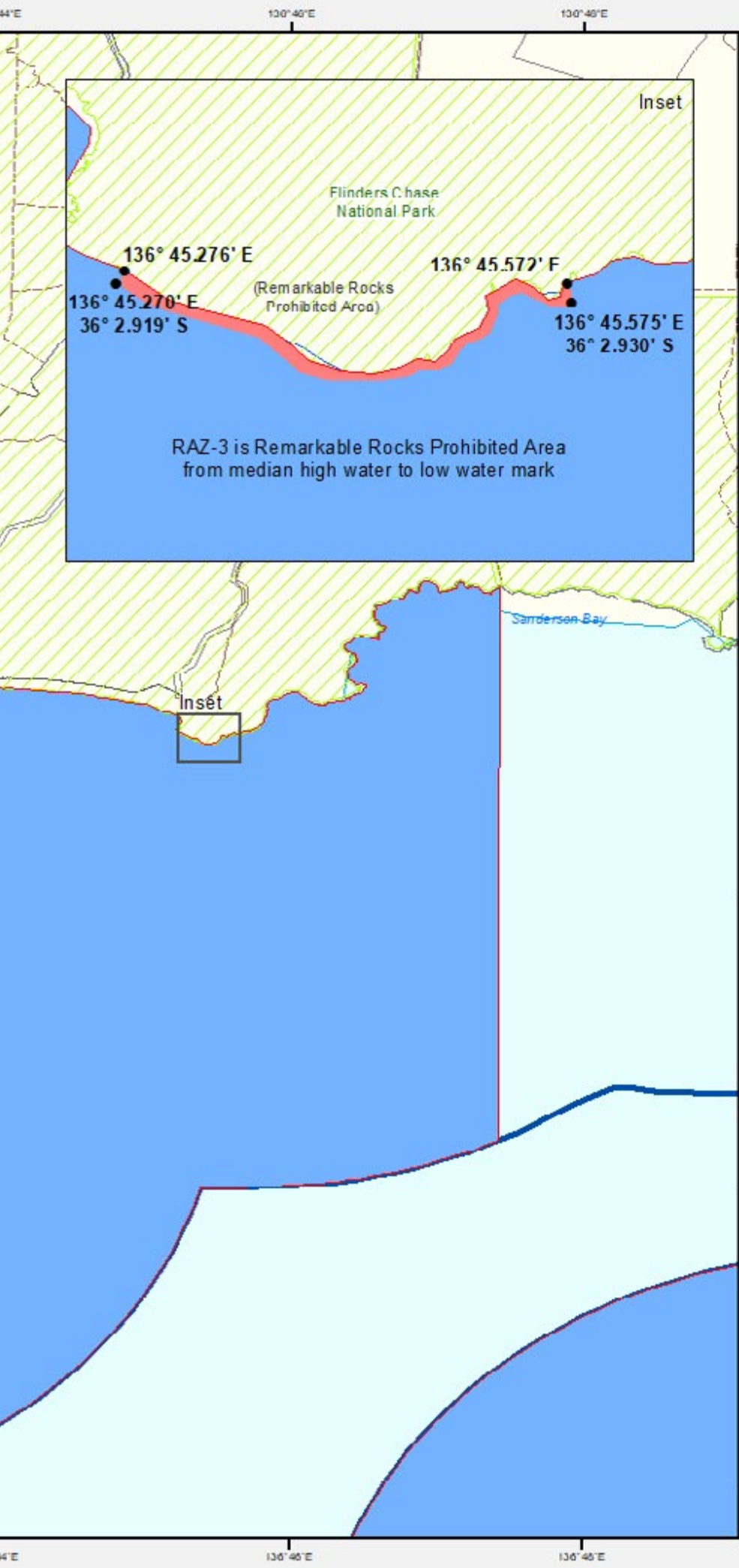
The zones are now defined in map 03(A) and map 04(A) (see attached, as well as map 01, map 02 and map 05 as defined in the Western Kangaroo Island Marine Park Management Plan 2012.

**Explanatory Notes:**

1. The coastal boundary of the park is the median high water mark (including the median high water mark of any estuaries), except where:
  - (a) the boundary extends inland from median high water mark to include in the park the areas specified in Schedules 1 and 2 of Rack Plan 1928; and
  - (b) the boundary extends seaward from median high water mark to exclude from the park the areas specified in Schedule 3 of Rack Plan 1928.
2. Unless otherwise specified, the seaward boundary of the park is the seaward boundary of the coastal waters of the State.

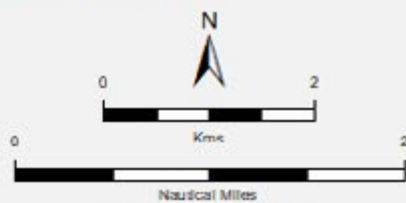

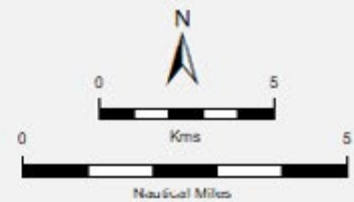
