

SOUTH AUSTRALIAN HERITAGE ACT, 1978-1980

Designation of State Heritage Area

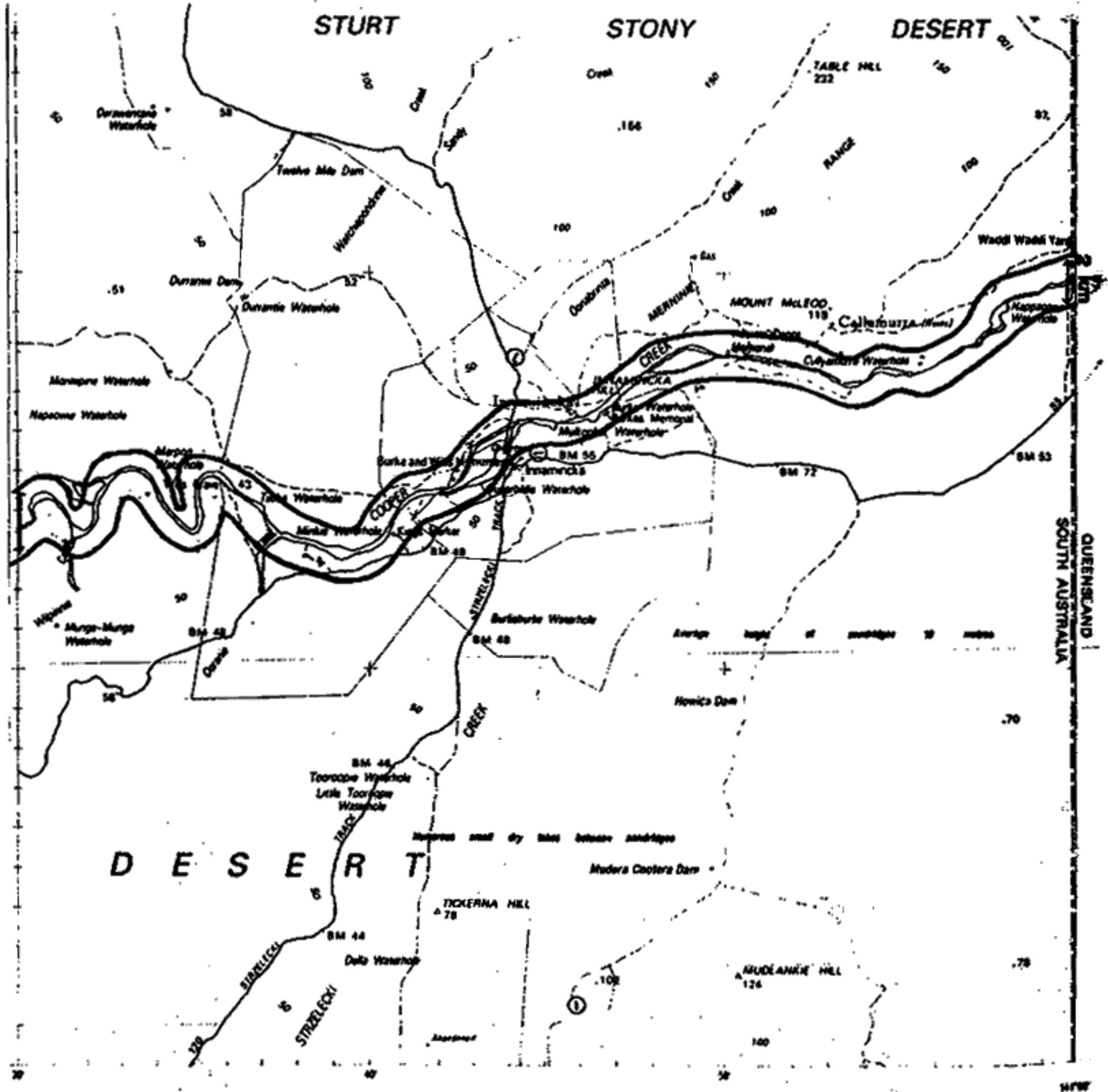
WHERE the Minister considers that an area of land is part of the physical, social or cultural heritage of the State and that it has significant aesthetic, historical or cultural interest, then the Minister may designate that area of land as a State Heritage Area.

Pursuant to the provisions of section 13 of the South Australian Heritage Act, 1978-1980, I, Don Hoggood, Minister for Environment and Planning and Minister for the time being administering the said Act hereby designate the area defined and shown in The Schedule as a State Heritage Area.

THE SCHEDULE

Description of Land

All that land lying between longitude 140°30'E and longitude 141°E, the boundary of State of South Australia and also situated within one kilometre from either side of Cooper Creek as delineated on the following plan.



The Innamincka/Cooper Creek State Heritage Area is that land within outer edge of boundary shown
