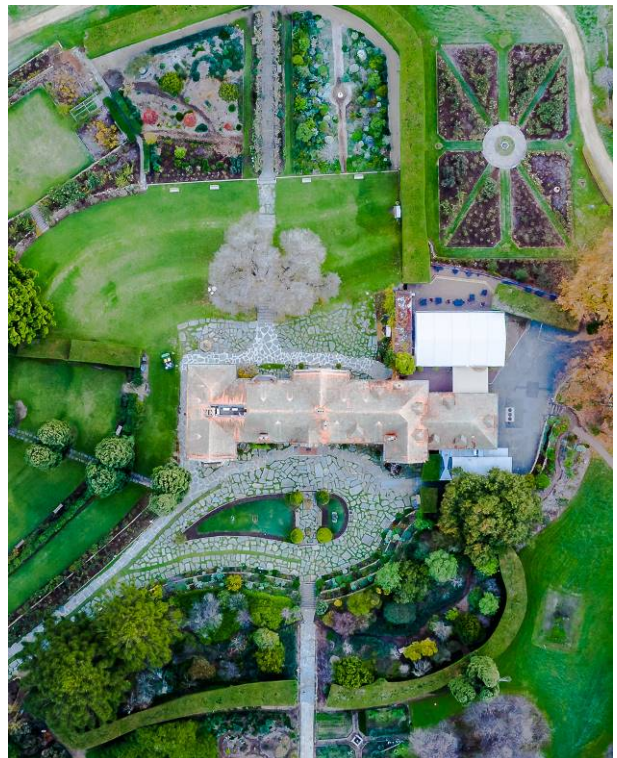

Also significant is that much of the interior furnishings dates back to the sixteenth century, in addition to holding world-recognised works of art and priceless antiques.
