Founded in 1881, the Art Gallery of South Australia is home to one of South Australia's great art collections, housed in one of Adelaide's most beautiful buildings. Located on North Terrace, between the South Australian Museum and University of Adelaide, the Art Gallery welcomes approximately 780,000 visitors each year.

The Art Gallery of South Australia's collection includes approximately 42,000 works of art and design from Australia, Europe, North America and Asia.

The sculpture 'The Life of Stars', by Lindy Lee was installed in February 2018 as part of the Adelaide Biennial. It is now a permanent feature on the forecourt of the Art Gallery of South Australia.
