DECISION NOTIFICATION

Clearance Application – 2019/2022/674

Dear John,

I refer to your application to the Native Vegetation Council (NVC) on behalf of Carillion Holdings Pty Ltd for consent to clear 15 River Red Gums for the purpose of managing 'wine taint' and clearance of 2.35 ha SEB Area to establish a new vineyard.

The Native Vegetation Assessment Panel (NVAP) would like to thank you for attending the meeting held on 3 December 2019. At the meeting NVAP considered your application in conjunction with your presentation, supporting information and a report from the Native Vegetation Branch.

Based on the information, NVAP resolved to refuse consent to the clearance of the 15 trees and the 2.35 ha SEB Area acknowledging the vegetation has high value habitat for Endangered and Vulnerable bird species and the clearance is seriously at variance with the Principles of Clearance. Additionally, termination of the SEB Area does not satisfy requirements of the NVC Policy for a Significant Environmental Benefit.

Please note, should you be able to identify an on-ground SEB area that provides long term benefit for the threatened species, NVAP would be willing to reconsider the application. The on-ground SEB would need to satisfy the *Guidelines for a Significant Environmental Benefit for the Clearance of Scattered Trees*, which you can download from the NVC Website Accredited Consultants page.
