West Kangaroo Island Parks Management Plan

The Department for Environment and Water is commencing the development of a new park management plan that will set the long-term vision for the parks of West Kangaroo Island. This plan will incorporate:

- Cape Bouguer Wilderness Protection Area
- Cape Gantheaume Wilderness Protection Area
- Cape Torrens Wilderness Protection Area
- Ravine des Casoars Wilderness Protection Area
- Western River Wilderness Protection Area

As required under section 31 of the *Wilderness Protection Act 1992*, preplanning submissions on the management of these wilderness protection areas are now invited from members of the public. Submissions should focus on matters that you think should be addressed in this management plan for Cape Bouguer, Cape Gantheaume, Cape Torrens, Ravine des Casoars and Western River Wilderness Protection Area.

All submissions received will be considered during the preparation of a draft management plan. The community will have an additional opportunity to make submissions after the draft management plan has been developed and released for public consultation.
