Application for a Permit to **HARVEST AND SELL OR USE PROTECTED ANIMALS – KANGAROO FIELD PROCESSOR PERMIT - CONCESSION (CLASS 13)**

Issued pursuant to [Section 60 J, National Parks and Wildlife Act, 1972](#)

A permit of this type allows the holder to shoot kangaroos on a property within the commercial harvest area of SA, and permits the sale of kangaroo carcasses to authorised Kangaroo Meat Processors. A Class 13 permit is only available to landowners, a member of their family (i.e. a spouse, parent, child, brother or sister) or their employees, and is limited to the property or properties of which they (or their employer or a member of their family) are the owner.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

The applicant is required to understand and comply with the National Parks and Wildlife (Kangaroo Harvesting) Regulations 2003 and the National Parks and Wildlife (Wildlife) Regulations 2016 under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*, and the National Code of Practice for the Humane Shooting of Kangaroos and Wallabies for Commercial Purposes (Environment Australia, 1990, as amended).

Download a copy of the [National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972](#) and Regulations. Should this permit be approved, an information package including the National Code of Practice for the Humane Shooting of Kangaroos and Wallabies for Commercial Purposes (Environment Australia, 1990, as amended) will be provided to you during the application interview or provided with your permit.

Prior to a permit being issued, the applicant must provide a copy of their Certificate of Accreditation for the Field Processing of Kangaroos from the Meat Hygiene Unit of the Department for Primary Industries and Resources SA. Before being accredited, the applicant must have successfully completed the TAFE Certificates in Game Meat Field Processing (or equivalent) and Kangaroo Field Processor Firearms Accuracy Accreditation.

It is a requirement of South Australia Police (SAPOL) that all kangaroo field processors hold a current Class B7 Firearms License. They must also have their vehicle tray inspected to verify it meets the Australian Standard for Hygienic Processing of Kangaroos for Human Consumption. Copies of the course certificates, together with the MHU accreditation number, will need to be presented with this application.

The applicant must apply in person to staff of the Kangaroo Management Program at 9 Mackay Street, Port Augusta. The applicant is also required to present identification to verify their name and address (eg driver's licence) and attend an interview. Contact (08) 8648 5318 to arrange an interview.

It is an offence to make a misleading or false declaration on the application.
