

SPECIALIST KEEP AND SELL ANIMALS PERMIT APPLICATION (Class 3) SOUTH AUSTRALIA 2018-19

A Specialist Keep and Sell Protected Animals Permit is a permit issued pursuant to section 58 of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972* that entitles the holder (being a person who does not carry on the business of dealing in protected animals) to keep, sell or give specialist animals identified in the permit by reference to the species or other class to which they belong.

This application does not cover applicants wishing to apply for the keeping of venomous snakes. Please refer to the "Specialist Keep and Sell Protected Animals Permit (Class 3) – Venomous snakes" application form.

Information supplied on this form will enable your application to be processed as prescribed by the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*. Your application must be assessed and a permit granted before you can proceed with the proposed activity. Your application may take up to eight (8) weeks to process.

- Please provide a detailed feeding plan including source of food and type of food to be provided for each species
- Please provide a copy of photographic identification that clearly states your full name, address and date of birth.
- Please note that as a part of the application process you may also be required to provide information to support that you have met requirements in line with species specific policy and guidelines.
