A Specialist Keep and Sell Protected Animals Permit is a permit issued pursuant to section 58 of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972* that entitles the holder (being a person who does not carry on the business of dealing in protected animals) to keep specialist animals identified in the permit by reference to the species or other class to which they belong that have been rescued as sick, injured or orphaned animals.

Information supplied on this form will enable your application to be processed as prescribed by the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*. Your application must be assessed and a permit granted before you can proceed with the proposed activity. Your application may take up to eight (8) weeks to process.
