This form is to be used to apply for a permit to destroy wildlife. Information requested will enable your application to be assessed as prescribed under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972. Your application must be assessed and approved by a delegated Department of Environment, Water and Natural Resources (DEWNR) officer and permit issued before animals can be destroyed.

Assessment considerations

This application will be assessed with consideration of the following;

1. Extent of economic/environmental damage being caused or is likely to be caused by wildlife,
2. Wildlife represents a threat to human safety,
3. A range of non lethal methods have been tried with limited success,
4. The destruction provides an effective method of minimising the impact of wildlife,
5. The technique used to take wildlife is humane and complies with appropriate Codes of Practice or animal welfare standards,
6. The impact of the activity will not detrimentally affect ecological sustainability and species conservation.

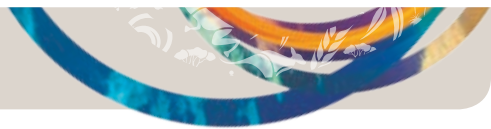
