Pursuant to Section 139 of the Natural Resources Management Act 2004

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Class 1: Restricted to drilling operations in single non flowing aquifer systems.

Class 2: In addition to operating in Class 1 conditions, permits drilling operations in multiple non flowing aquifer systems.

Class 3: In addition to operating in Class 1 and 2 conditions, permits drilling operations in flowing aquifer systems.

- DICAT** course of ADITC* or equivalent

- Completed one of the following; at least six class 2 wells under the supervision of a licensed class 2 driller; or at least six class 1 wells and three class 2 wells under the supervision of a licensed class 2 driller

- Demonstrated drilling and grouting knowledge

Option (c)

- Class 2 exam of the ADITC* or equivalent
- Been issued with a Class 2 driller's licence in another State or Territory of the Commonwealth
- Additional information to satisfy the department that the licence and experience are equivalent to that required of licensed driller in South Australia (check with the department)

Class 3 Licence

- Class 3 exam of the ADITC* or equivalent course
- Employed as a driller for a period not less than 24 months, and held a class 2 licence for not less than 12 months
- Drilled at least six class 2 wells and three class 3 wells under the supervision of a licensed class 3 driller

- Demonstrated drilling and grouting knowledge

Option (b)

- Class 3 exam of the ADITC* or equivalent course
- Employed as a driller and held a class 2 licence for a period not less than 12 months
- Drilled six class 2 wells and three class 3 wells drilled under the supervision of a licensed class 3 driller

- DICAT** course of the ADITC* or equivalent course

- Demonstrated drilling and grouting knowledge
